

Bioinnovation Wales

Project Description

A high-level training programme aimed at the agri-food and biotech sectors. Training is delivered on-line with optional workshops where appropriate. Courses can be taken as CPD or built towards a range of postgraduate qualifications.

The project intends to enhance innovation and productivity of the Welsh biotech and food companies and to improve their associated supply chains. This will be achieved by addressing the 'complementary problems' of:

- High level and technical skills shortages in bio-based businesses; and
- Under-utilisation of graduates in Wales

The operation provides Postgraduate level training to help Welsh businesses to embrace the circular economy and provide a route for their employees to gain postgraduate qualifications.

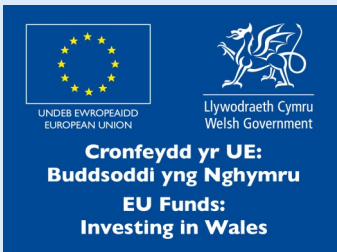
