

ESF Priority 1 Funded Projects in the CCR: Tackling Unemployment



Communities 4 Work

Mentoring & employment support to help LTU & El adults in hard-to-reach groups into work. Communities First areas.

Learning to Grow

Work with EI individuals to engage in voluntary work schemes, focusing on those with long term mental health issues.

Active Inclusion Fund

Grants for engagement / supported employment for those: aged 54+ (EI), BME (LTU), carers (EI), jobless households, low skilled, work limiting health condition

Achieving Change through Employment (ACE)

Supports BAME and migrant people in Wales eligible to live & work in the UK. Empowerment and mentoring support into training, volunteering and employment.

PaCE

Helping El parents aged 25 plus in to sustainable work, where childcare is their main barrier. Non Communities First areas.

ReACT III

Supports adults made redundant / at risk of being so find employment. Advice & guidance from Careers Wales, training grants & a wage subsidy for employers.

Staying Well at Work (RCT Only)

SMEs: equality & diversity policies & systems; health promotion & monitoring support Individuals: mental & physical health support, 1:1 mentoring for long-term absence from work

ESF P1 Objectives

- To increase the employability of those closest to the labour market at most risk of poverty.
- To increase the employability of Economically Inactive and Long Term Unemployed people aged 25 and over, who have complex barriers to employment.
- To reduce under-employment or absence rates for employed individuals with work limiting health conditions and / or other barriers to sustainable engagement with the labour market

Jobsense

Specialist, tailored, employability services aimed at people with sensory loss. Delivered by RNID, RNIB and Elite

Journey 2 Work

Targeting those furthest from labour market using compreshensive support package & placements. Focus on non-Communities First/Communities For Work areas.

Bridges into Work 2

Intensive training & 1:1 mentoring for LTU / EI adults 25+, living in non Communities First areas. Bridgend, Torfaen, Caerphilly, Merthyr & Blaenau Gwent only

HWW - Out of Work Service

Peer mentoring & specialist employment support to EI/ LTU 25+ adults recovering from substance misuse and/ or mental health issues. Also transitional support for up to three months when participants find work.

HWW - In-work Support

Prevents job loss from work-limiting health conditions using rapid access to early physiotherapy, psychological therapy & occupational therapy. Bridgend only in the CCR

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NET

Support underemployed adults to improve their labour market situation. Also adults with a work-limiting health condition / disability return to work / improve their job situation. Bridgend, Torfaen, Caerphilly, Merthyr & Blaenau Gwent only
