



## Inspire 2 Work West Wales and the Valleys - Case Study 2

X was referred to I2W for support from C4W- he was CFW postcode area however they had made attempts to work with X but he had not engaged.

Inspire were happy to attempt to work with X.

Worker completed all assessments and identified the needs and put an action plan together with X to help him achieve his goals.

X worked hard and engaged throughout the support.

X achieved his CSCS card plus worked with Inspire to build his professional CV and to apply for jobs of interest.

X took all the advice and support on board and following an interview he secured employment.

During support X became a dad for the first time which he was delighted about and is thoroughly enjoying being a father.

Although becoming a father was positive, himself and his partner had some issues with housing.

Inspire were able to help X and partner with their housing issues and supported them through the process of accessing emergency housing provision. As this was not a permeant solution X securing employment quickened the offer of affordable housing and they are set to move in to their new home on Monday 3rd may.

Additionally throughout the support X had some tragic news when his father passed away and during closure paperwork he told his worker that his grandmother had also now passed away. X is managing to maintain the employment, be a new father, grieve for the loss of his family and move into a new home. X has been offered to contact Inspire2work in the future should he need any further support and was also provided with contact details of additional emotional wellbeing support should X feel he needs it.
